- Members racket Club – 26 Tennis Courts (17 Floodlit, 9 grass), 7 Padel courts, 4 Squash Courts, clubhouse offering hospitality, pro-shop & ancillary facilities
- 2200 members of all ages, over 600 children & adults attending coaching courses weekly
- 2021 – Environmental/net zero commitment statement developed

Aim – working towards net zero in line with Cheltenham Borough Councils aim by 2030



• Support from Cheltenham Borough Council

- Cheltenham Zero Community Fund
 - September 2022 – Replace out of date metal halide floodlights with new energy efficient LED lights on courts 5 – 7
 - £8,000 towards a project total of £33k
- Cheltenham Zero Grant Scheme
 - April 2024 – Replace out of date metal halide floodlights with new energy efficient LED lights on courts 8 - 11
 - £6,097 towards a project total of £44k
- Reduced energy used on these courts by half from 56kWh to 28kWh
- Funding allowed us to speed up conversion.
- Aim for future courts to be converted in time

- External audit with Severn Wye Energy to review all areas of the Club and highlight opportunities
- Growth hub support analysing our carbon footprint
